Dear Dr. Koroivulaono:

The San Francisco - Seattle School Participation Division has completed its review of College of Micronesia-FSM's (Institution) Application for Approval to Participate in the Federal Student Financial Aid Programs.

Our analysis of the materials which you submitted, indicates that the Institution meets the minimum requirements of institutional eligibility, administrative capability, and financial responsibility as set forth in 34 C.F.R. Parts 600 and 668.

To complete the recertification process, the Institution must review, sign and return the Program Participation Agreement (PPA) by uploading the signed¹ PPA via the Common Origination and Disbursement (COD) Document Center.

After the signed PPA is received from you, the San Francisco - Seattle School Participation Division will generate an Eligibility and Certification Approval Report (ECAR). The ECAR will summarize the critical elements of the Institution's approved application. The ECAR will also identify the Institution's highest level of offering, any nondegree or short term training programs and any additional locations which are Title IV, HEA eligible.

Upon execution of the PPA by the Secretary, the Institution shall be certified to participate in Title IV, HEA programs until September 30, 2028. The San Francisco - Seattle School Participation Division will notify the respective Federal Student Aid (FSA) program offices of the Institution's eligibility to receive Title IV funds.

The Institution has thirty days from the date of this letter to sign and return the PPA. The Institution's failure to respond within the allotted time frame will constitute a withdrawal of the Institution's application from consideration.
