Review of Board Policy 8800

RECOMMENDED DIRECTIVE:

The Board hereby approves the amendments to Board Policies: 8800 (College-Owned Devices)

DISCUSSION:

Policies and procedures are living documents designed to adapt to the evolving nature of an organization. While the core principles of a policy may endure, the specific details should be adaptable and responsive to the organization’s shift. Consequently, the Vice President of Institutional Effectiveness and Quality Assurance (IEQA) consistently engages in collaboration and coordination with relevant offices and standing committees within the college to assess policies and procedures.

Following endorsement by the **Information, Communication and Technology** standing committee on February 25, the Executive Committee reviewed and recommends the following approval by the Board of Regents for April 7, 2026:
