~~A division/campus may request Curriculum Committee to discontinue a course at the college if the course has not been taught for three years or when the program is revised and the course is no longer required. The course will also be removed from the catalog.~~

A petition shall be initiated to the Curriculum Committee to discontinue a course if the course has not been offered for three consecutive academic years, or if a formal program revision determines that the course has become redundant or is no longer relevant to the program requirements. Upon approval by the Curriculum Committee, the course shall be removed from the official list of course offerings in the subsequent edition of the College Catalog.
