Dining and Food Services Policy

The College of Micronesia–FSM shall operate dining services to provide safe, nutritious, and reasonably priced meals to students, faculty, staff, and authorized visitors across the College’s campuses and programs.

Dining services may include dining halls, mess halls, cafeterias, and other food service operations operated by the College. These services are intended to support the health and well-being of the college community and enhance student experience.

Dining services shall operate on a cost-recovery basis and are not intended to generate institutional profit.

All dining service operations shall comply with applicable public health, sanitation, and food safety regulations.
