**Catalog Limitations**

~~A maximum of ten calendar years is allowed to fulfill the baccalaureate degree requirements of selected major and eight years is allowed to fulfill the associate degree and third-year certificate requirements of selected major as described in the catalog which was in force at the time of admission.~~

Students are governed by the certificate and degree requirements stipulated in the catalog in effect at the time of their initial admission. *These are referred to as the students' catalog rights.* However, to ensure academic currency, the following time limits apply for completing those specific requirements:

- Baccalaureate Degrees: A maximum of 10 calendar years.
- Certificate of achievement, Associate Degrees & Third-Year Certificates: A maximum of 8 calendar years.

Students who do not complete their program within these timeframes will lose their original "catalog rights." Such students must then fulfill the requirements of the catalog in effect at the time the limit was exceeded or at the time of their subsequent graduation application.
