

Tokyo Metropolitan University Exchange Program

Tokyo Metropolitan University and Tokyo Metropolitan College of Industrial Technology are inviting 8 students from the Federated States of Micronesia to participate in a short-term program from November 8-13, 2026 (previously participated students are not eligible).

Program Content: Japanese culture classes, events, and other activities such as facility tour related to the environment.

Expenses: Each participant shall be responsible for paying 20,000 yen, and visa application fees (roughly \$155 USD in total). Roundtrip airfare and costs associated with staying in Japan/accommodations, food and transportation within Japan shall be borne by the Tokyo Metropolitan Government.

Requirements:

COM-FSM internal selection criteria:

1. Must be a current full-time student with at least 30 credits taken from the degree programs or 15 credits taken from the certificate program registered for Fall 2026.
2. GPA should be ranked from the highest, based on the cumulated GPA. This selection is capped at GPA 3.7 (cumulative) and above.
3. Previously participated students of any exchange program in representing the college are not eligible for the selection in order to give the chance to other outstanding students.
4. If all credentials are the same, the position should be given to prioritize sophomores/or the last semester students with the highest QP / Hrs earned along with the highest GPA.

Application items:

- A COM-FSM transcript with all semesters with grades (unofficial is acceptable). Include the latest semester with grades (summer 2026) if register in summer. The cumulated GPA should be 3.7 and above to apply.
- A valid passport with at least 6 months of duration at the time of travel is needed upon selection. The student should be responsible for the passport fees.

The Vice President of Instructional Affairs office will announce the selection result by August 14, 2026 (Only the selected students will receive the email notification).
